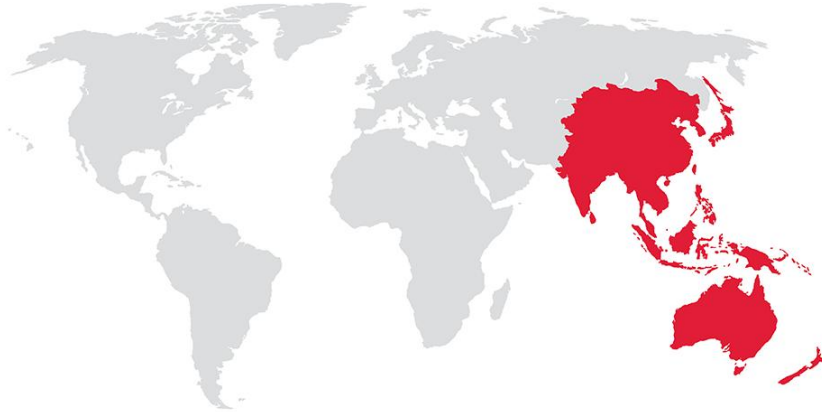




TERRITORY DEFINITION

“APAC”

(Asian Pacific)



When used by NetAlly, LLC “APAC” shall mean the following countries:

Australia, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, China, Hong Kong, Cook Islands, Fiji, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kiribati, Laos, Malaysia, Maldives, Marshall Islands, Micronesia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nauru, Nepal, New Zealand, Pakistan, Palau, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Russia, Samoa, Singapore, Solomon Islands, South Korea, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Thailand, Timor Leste, Tonga, Tuvalu, Vanuatu, and Viet Nam.

- NetAlly’s definition of “APAC” includes any territories belonging to a country listed above, such as Christmas Island (belonging to Australia), as long as the territory is recognized by the United States Government.
- Before NetAlly Channel Partners may commence doing business in furtherance of the Channel Partner Agreement, such Channel Partners are required to enter into an amendment (“Rider”) to the Channel Partner Agreement, which addresses country-specific export restrictions for: CHINA, HONG KONG, RUSSIA.
- **The definition of “APAC” *SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDES* the following countries for which, due to U. S. Government regulations, NetAlly products cannot be shipped: North Korea.**
