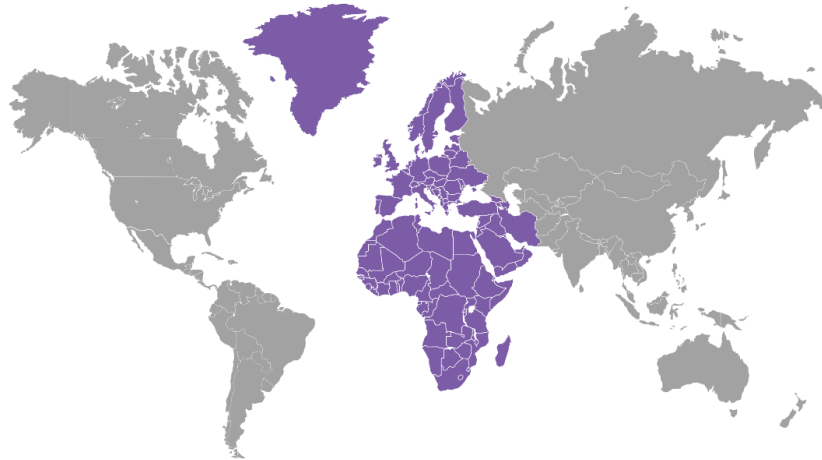




TERRITORY DEFINITION

“EMEA”

(Europe, Middle East, and Africa)



When used by NetAlly, LLC “EMEA” shall mean the following countries:

Afghanistan*, Albania, Algeria, Andorra, Angola, Austria, Bahrain, Belgium, Benin, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Botswana, Bulgaria, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Cape Verde, Central African Republic, Chad, Comoros, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Djibouti, Egypt, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Estonia, Ethiopia, Faroe Islands, Finland, France, Gabon, Gambia, Georgia, Germany, Ghana, Gibraltar, Greece, Guernsey, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Hungary, Iceland, Iraq, Ireland, The Isle of Man, Israel, Italy, Ivory Coast, Jersey, Jordan, Kenya, Kuwait, Latvia, Lebanon, Lesotho, Liberia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Madagascar, Malawi, Mali, Mauritania, Mauritius, Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, Morocco, Mozambique, Namibia, Netherlands, Niger, Nigeria, Norway, North Macedonia, Oman, Palestine, Poland, Portugal, Qatar, Romania, Rwanda, San Marino, Sao Tome and Principe, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Somalia, South Africa, Spain, Swaziland, Sweden, Switzerland, Tanzania, Togo, Tunisia, Turkey, Uganda, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom, Vatican City, Western Sahara, Zambia, and Zimbabwe.

- NetAlly’s definition of “EMEA” includes any territories belonging to a country listed above, such as French Guiana (belonging to France), as long as the territory is recognized by the United States Government.
- Before NetAlly’s Channel Partners can commence doing business in furtherance of the Channel Agreement, such Channel Partners are required to enter into an amendment (“Rider”) to the Channel Partner Agreement, which addresses the country-specific export restrictions for: CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC, IRAQ, KUWAIT, LEBANON, MALI, QATAR, SAUDI ARABIA.

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- The definition of “EMEA” ***SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDES*** the following countries for which, due to U. S. Government regulations, international import restrictions, and/or NetAlly Policies, NetAlly products cannot be shipped: Belarus, Burundi, Democratic Republic of Congo, Libya, Iran, Republic of South Sudan, Serbia, Sudan, Syria, Ukraine (Crimea Region), Yemen.
- * Sales into Afghanistan may be restricted due to license requirements. Preapproval is required from Channel Operations before customer engagement.

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
