

TERRITORY DEFINITION

"Latin America"



When used by NetAlly, LLC "Latin America" shall mean the following countries:

Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Bahamas, Barbados, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Grenada, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Puerto Rico, and Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, Uruguay.

- NetAlly's definition of "Latin America" includes the independent countries of the Caribbean islands listed above, such as Grenada. NetAlly's definition of "Latin America" does <u>not</u> include dependent territories located in the Caribbean islands, such as Anguilla (belonging to the United Kingdom). Dependent territories are included in NetAlly's territory definition of their sovereign state.
- The definition of "Latin America" *SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDES* the following countries for which, due to U. S. Government regulations, NetAlly products cannot be shipped: Cuba, Venezuela.
