



TERRITORY DEFINITION

“Sub-Saharan Africa”

(Sub-Saharan Africa & Associated Territory)



When used by NetAlly, “Sub-Saharan Africa” shall mean the following countries:

Angola, Benin, Botswana, Burkina Faso, Central African Republic, Cabo Verde, Cameroon, Cape Verde, Chad, Cote d’Ivoire (Ivory Coast), Comoros, Republic of Congo (Brazzaville), Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Eswatini, Ethiopia, Gabon, The Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Kenya, Liberia, Lesotho, Madagascar, Mali, Malawi, Mauritania, Mauritius, Mozambique, Namibia, Niger, Nigeria, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Seychelles, Sierra Leona, Somalia, South Africa, Tanzania, Togo, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

- Before NetAlly’s Channel Partners may commence doing business in furtherance of the Channel Partner Agreement, such Channel Partners are required to enter into an amendment (“Rider”) to the Channel Partner Agreement, which addresses the country-specific export restrictions for: CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC, MALI.
- The definition of “Sub-Saharan Africa” ***SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDES*** the following countries for which, due to U. S. Government regulations, NetAlly products cannot be shipped: **Democratic Republic of Congo, South Sudan, Sudan.**
